The voice is the most valuable, irreplaceable instrument you'll ever own. You can't play it with your hands, nor can you see it. It has everything any other instrument has: multiple acoustics, resonators, strings, an internal "fretboard", pitch sensitivities, an amazing range – you name it! And yet very few of us really know how to navigate it or use it correctly, how to preserve this wondrous instrument at peak condition for an entire lifetime.
